## Jackson car show to help Katrina victims

**T**hey're cars with a cause. The Mississippi Classic Cruisers Car Club will shake, rattle and roll into Smith-Wills Stadium in Jackson Saturday.

The event, also hosted by Madison's Rosa Scott School, is a Katrina relief benefit for Bay High School in Bay St. Louis.

Madison County resident Tom Phillips, club director, said this is the second year for the Shake, Rattle and Roll Car Show.

"This year, we wanted to do something for fellow Mississippians along the Gulf Coast who were affected by Katrina," he said.

The show is set for 11 a.m.-3 p.m. Attendees are encouraged to bring canned goods to donate. Vehicle registration for entrants will be held from 9-11 a.m. Awards will be given to the top 25 cars and top five trucks during a 2:30 p.m. presentation.

The event is free. Door prizes, kids' games, food and oldies music will be offered. If it rains, the event will be rescheduled for June 3.

Rosa Scott School adopted Bay High ear-

lier this year, and car club members decided to partner with the school.

"If the staff and students are willing to contribute their time and energy to help Bay High School, we thought the least we could do is provide some funding to support the effort as well," Phillips said. "Bay St. Louis is still trying to rebuild and provide the students with the best education possible. Things like books for the library and computer equipment for the students are among the many things that need to be replaced."

Phillips said about 200 antique, classic and special interest vehicles will be displayed at the event.
